Eagleville Hospital is taking its mission outdoors by continuing the transformation of our 40-acre campus. Our goal is to promote a safe, holistic, and patient-centered environment, surrounded by sustainable green space. We invite you to be part of this transformation through your generous support.

Gardening and time spent outdoors offer a healing refuge, grounding the mind in the present and nurturing a sense of purpose through nature’s quiet rhythms. In the soil and sunlight, many find a path back to themselves. ***As we tend to the chores of mulching, weeding, and planting this spring, these simple tasks represent an array of calming and meditative exercises that patients value as part of their treatment.***

Gardening reduces stress, anxiety, and depression while fostering a sense of purpose, responsibility, and accomplishment. For individuals in treatment, and those transitioning back into their communities, ***gardening is a stable, structured activity that promotes mindfulness and skill development—qualities essential for sustained long-term recovery.***

Eagleville is transforming five key locations within the campus to advance the goals of the therapeutic horticulture program. Starting with an indoor vertical, hydroponic planter, our multi-phase comprehensive masterplan includes:

- ***A Free-Standing Greenhouse*** – A dedicated space for year-round horticultural therapy. Patients will learn to start seeds and grow fruits and vegetables that they can eat as part of a healthy diet.
- ***Raised Beds and Traditional Garden Beds*** – Accessible garden beds constructed to accommodate all patients, including those who use wheelchairs and other adaptive devices.
- ***Residential Gazebo Landscaping*** – To enhance relaxation, meditation, and group therapy sessions.
- ***Sustainable and Patient-Focused Green Spaces*** – Designed to evolve with patient’s needs.
- ***Exercise-focused Walking Path*** – To expand the current ‘Path of Hope’ to include various exercise stations and educational tips to guide sustainability of a healthy lifestyle.
